### **Project Overview**

The City of Garnett seeks funding from the Federal Aviation Administration for funding available through the Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) program for their Garnett Municipal Airport- Runway 1-19 Reconstruction - Phase 2 Land Acquisition Project. The project which includes Expansion and improvements to runway 1-19 at Garnett Municipal Airport.

This opportunity is a Formula BIL program with a local match requirement of 10% of the total project cost. The entity is requesting \$15,331.00 from the Build Kansas Fund, and is providing a local match of \$15,332.00 This request has the potential to unlock \$275,960.00 in federal funds, for a total project cost of \$306,623.00.

The deadline is September 30, 2025 and this Build Kansas Fund application was received on February 13, 2025.

# **Runway 1-19 Reconstruction - Phase 2 Land Acquisition**

### **Project Justification**

The existing Runway 1-19 at Garnett has reached the end of its usable life and has significant safety issues.

- The pavement has a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) rating of 50 (Poor).
- The runway length/width of 2,660' x 45' is insufficient to meet minimum FAA standards. (3,400' x 75' is justified base on the current Master Plan.)
- County roads are too close to the current runway thresholds, and do not provide adequate approach surface clearance over adjacent roads or adequate Runway Safety Area (RSA) distance beyond the runway ends.
- The high point near the middle of the runway is 16' higher than the Runway 1 threshold and violates Line-of-Sight requirements.
- The partial parallel taxiway offset from the runway does not meet minimum FAA standards (Existing offset = 78', FAA standard offset = 240')

### <u>Eligibility</u>

Per the FAA AIP Handbook Section 3-81 (Table 3-48) and Section 3-86 (Table 3-52), land acquisition is an eligible grant cost if justified on the Airport Layout Plan. Eligible costs include the actual acquisition as well as boundary surveys, appraisals, relocation expenses, and updates to the Airport property map.

### **Aligning with KDOT Aviation Goals**

One of the objectives of the State System plan completed by KDOT Aviation in 2016 was to analyze the facilities and services at Kansas airports and compare them to preferred minimum benchmarks that were established for each category of airport. The result was to set targeted actions (recommendations) that would enable individual airports to better serve their respective markets.

At the Garnett Municipal Airport, this analysis identified 6 deficiencies (one of the highest of any airport in the state) and gave recommended actions to meet the minimum recommended levels for a Community Airport.

- 1. Extend Runway
- 2. Widen Runway
- 3. Develop Non-Precision Approaches
- 4. Install Medium Intensity Runway Lights
- 5. Construct Hangar Space for 3 Aircraft
- 6. Install AWOS
